Mexican Martyrs



The Mexican Revolution in the 1920s brought persecution to Catholics. Missionaries were expelled. Seminaries and schools were closed. The Church was forbidden to own property. Priests and laymen who refused to denounce Jesus and their faith publicly were tortured and murdered. Six Knights of Columbus—all priests—were martyred for refusing to renounce the faith: Fathers Miguel de la Mora de la Mora, Pedro de Jesus Maldonado Lucero, Jose Maria Robles Hurtado, Rodgrigo Aguilar Aleman, Luis Batiz Sainz and Mateo Correa Magallanes. The Knights did not retreat in Mexico but grew dramatically. As a result, the Order in Mexico is vibrant today. Mexican Knights annually perform nearly 300,000 hours of volunteer service in support of Church, community and young people.

Worthy Squires!

Many of us get so caught up in the commercialization of Christmas what with Black Friday, Cyber Monday, and the endless sales of material goods that it is so easy to forget exactly what we are celebrating and why. The Knights of Columbus have a campaign which is entitled "Keep Christ in Christmas." The purpose of this is to remind people that Christmas is above all a holy day celebrating the birth of Christ.
