

Chaplain's Report

Dear Brother Knights,

During the month of May, we honor Our Blessed Mother Mary with marked devotions such as May Crownings, May altars, extra praying of the Holy Rosary and other ways. Another way I learned she is being honored is by being the patroness of a new Catholic Radio Station available in our State of RI called "Relevant Radio WSJW - 550 AM.

Yes, Mary, under the title of "Our Lady of Guadalupe," is the patroness of this station. What a station it is! Have you heard of it before reading this article? Bishop Thomas Tobin wrote about it in his recent bi-weekly article in the April 26th edition of our Catholic Newspaper - "The Rhode Island Catholic" (formerly "The Providence Visitor"). You may want to read the whole article. It is wonderfully informative about what this new Radio Station is all about.

Here is a quote from our Bishop about WSJW: "Without a doubt Relevant Radio is thoroughly Catholic. It accepts and promotes, without embarrassment or hesitation, the teaching of the Church; it respects and supports the ministry of our Holy Father and our bishops, and it is placed under the protection of our Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Guadalupe."

The Bishop goes on to write a number of reasons why we need a radio station like this in our day, especially. He sees this Station as a significant source of help for evangelization efforts.

I would encourage all of you, Brothers, to familiarize yourselves with this Station. Listen to it from time to time (perhaps while driving). Recommend it to others. Make some donation to help support it (It relies of listener donations to operate. Pray that many people will be enlightened by the sound Catholic perspective that is presented.

Brothers, it is sooooo important that we get the clear message of what is happening in the Catholic World. We are getting more and more of a distorted presentation of our Church in the secular media. I encourage you to listen, learn, tell others and support "Relevant Radio." Our Lady of Guadalupe is praying for us.

The Msgr. Peter E. Blessing Foundation

We have invested \$75K of the proceeds from the sale of our building into the Vanguard Wellington Fund.

I would like to see it called "The MSGR. PETER E. BLESSING FOUNDATION" which will be similar to the "BISHOP MCVINNEY FOUNDATION." The Bishop McVinney Foundation was set up by a group of lay Catholic gentlemen from a donation given to them by the Bishop's sister which I understand was a sizable amount. The earrings from the foundation have been used over the years to benefit the seminarians of Our Lady of Providence Seminary to foster future vocation.

You can do a Google search on Vanguard Wellington fund on the computer and it will give you all the information you need to know about the fund. I would like to have it as simple as possible so that we can donate the proceeds to the Seminary and let them use it for their needs. It would also be nice to see a scholarship given annually to a needy Catholic high school student.

I hope to see an annual income of \$5K a year from the fund.

Naturally, this is not set in stone and we have a lot of planning to do over the next year. Needless to say a committee will have to be set up. That is the gist of it and I have high hopes for its success.

St. Damien of Molokai



St. Damien is known as the "Apostle of the Lepers." He answered the call to Molokai, the Hawaiian leper colony. He served the physical, medical and spiritual needs of the lepers there by building a church for them, dressing their ulcers, building homes, coffins and digging graves. He became their most effective advocate for obtaining promised government support. He eventually contracted – and died of – the disease.

"Holiness is not perfection according to human criteria; it is not reserved for a small number of exceptional persons. It is the Lord who brings us the salvation of the world for the glory of God, despite our sin and our sometimes rebellious temperament." - Pope John Paul II at the beatification of St. Damien of Molokai.
