

Recently I saw the movie "For Greatly Glory - the true story of Cristiada". As you probably know it was the feature article in the May issue of Columbia Magazine. I hope many of you have also seen it or will see it soon. It is well worth the time and I'll tell you why I say this.

The movie does a great job of showing how secular/anti-Catholic government leaders caused terrible loss of life and suppression of faith. For example, over 160 priests were martyred while thousands of other priests fled the country or went underground! From 1926 to June 21st 1929 the Cristeros War raged throughout the country. In losses among government military and the Cristeros fighters and the common people combined over 250,000 lives were lost in Mexico. It is no wonder these events are little known because they are so sad and almost seem unbelievable to happen on our North American continent in such recent times.


Dear Brothers, the sobering reality is OUR religious liberties are being threatened today in the U.S.A.! The HHS Mandate and other measures have already limited our free practice of our religion. The Msgr. Peter E. Blessing Foundation

We have invested \$75K of the proceeds from the sale of our building into the Vanguard Wellington Fund.

I would like to see it called "The MSGR. PETER E. BLESSING FOUNDATION" which will be similar to the "BISHOP MCVINNEY FOUNDATION." The Bishop McVinney Foundation was set up by a group of lay Catholic gentlemen from a donation given to them by the Bishop's sister which I understand was a sizable amount. The earrings from the foundation have been used over the years to benefit the seminarians of Our Lady of Providence Seminary to foster future vocation.

You can do a Google search on Vanguard Wellington fund on the computer and it will give you all the information you need to know about the fund. I would like to have it as simple as possible so that we can donate the proceeds to the Seminary and let them use it for their needs. It would also be nice to see a scholarship given annually to a needy Catholic high school student.

I hope to see an annual income of \$5K a year from the fund.

Naturally, this is not set in stone and we have a lot of planning to do over the next year. Needless to say a committee will have to be set up. That is the gist of it and I have high hopes for its success.



St. Rafael Guizar Valencia



St. Rafael Guizar Valencia, known as "the bishop of the poor" cared for the wounded, sick and dying during Mexico's 1910-20 revolution. He was a special target for persecution because of his outspoken defense of the Church.

He was forced to live in hiding in order to continue his work as a priest and bishop. He escaped to Guatemala and Cuba and returned to Mexico in 1929.
