COLUMBIAN SQUIRES PROGRAM



Unfortunately, the Father Leo Anctil Circle #5211 will be suspended as of January 16, 2017. The last meeting was held on Friday, January 6. The reason for this is that the documentation held at Supreme headquarters shows that two of our four counselors do not have all the requirements completed in the Safe Training Program. This is an error on Supreme's part because all requirements were complete by all four counselors as of mid-2015. No notifications were made by Supreme to our Council about delinquent requirements until last month - an entire year and a half transpired! In early December, a form letter was addressed to Michael Benson, RI State Deputy, from Brian Gedicks, the Director of Youth Protection telling us that the requirements were delinquent and gave only one month to take care of the What was also unfortunate was that the documentation kept by me on my laptop was lost in September 2015 when my hard drive crashed. I did have a backup drive, but found that it had crashed, too. All my data was lost including that safe training documentation.

Also, I would like to make mention that I believe the Squires program has really never been supported fully by Supreme, and given the new Domestic Church Initiative started by the Supreme Knight, Carl Anderson, which instructs Councils not to start new Squires Circles. It also instructs Councils to advise the youth, including Squires, to join their respective Church youth group. As such, I will step down as the Chief Counselor of the Circle and the State Squires Chairman to join Fr. Fleming at the SSJP Youth Group as a Chaperone. I have asked the Squires who are old enough to join us either at SSJP Youth Group or join their respective youth group. I am disappointed the Circle ended this way, but unfortunately, this is new direction of the Knights of Columbus.

I would also like to thank Father Prior Rev. Paul Lemoi, Past Father Prior Rev. Robert Forcier, Past Chief Counselor Tom Del Mastro, all Counselors past and present and all Squires past and present for their commitment to a great program.
