Chaplain's Corner

No Report This Month

Knights Urged to Join in Novena for Legal Protection of Human Life

Motivated by the upcoming change on the Supreme Court, the Knights of Columbus is urging its members and all Catholics to join in a novena to pray for the protection of human life in the law. The novena, which Cardinal Dolan called for in mid-July, will be a nine-week prayer effort every Friday from Aug. 3 to Sept. 28.

When Cardinal Dolan announced the novena as chairman of the U.S. bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities, he expressed concerns about lobbying by "pro-abortion groups" against confirmation of Judge Brett Kavanaugh, President Donald Trump's nominee to replace now-retired Justice Anthony Kennedy.

"While the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops does not support or oppose the confirmation of any presidential nominee," the cardinal said, "we can and should raise grave concerns about a confirmation process which is being grossly distorted by efforts to subject judicial nominees to a litmus test of support for Roe v. Wade. And we must pray." Carl Anderson, the Supreme Knight of the Knights of Columbus, said: "We join our pastors in praying that the confirmation process will help lead to a court that upholds the right to life of every person, as it is the prerequisite for all other rights guaranteed by our Constitution."

Materials for the "Call to Prayer" novena are available at <u>https://bit.ly/2JBU1MH</u>. Those who participate in the novena can sign up at www.usccb.org/pray to receive weekly notifications by text or email in addition to material about Roe v. Wade and its aftermath.

Those participating are asked to fast on Fridays and say an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be for the intention.

In addition, the of Columbus Supreme Convention will be broadcast by four popular Catholic media outlets. Live coverage will be provided by the Eternal Word Television Network (<u>EWTN</u>), Canada's <u>Salt and Light Television</u>, and Boston-based <u>CatholicTV</u>. <u>SiriusXM</u> Radio's The Catholic Channel will also broadcast from the event, taking place at the Baltimore Convention Center.

The three television networks will broadcast the proceedings throughout opening day, Tuesday, Aug. 7, and all the Wednesday and Thursday morning Masses. Events begin at 9:30 a.m. EDT with the Opening Mass, celebrated by Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore. The convention's Opening Business Session, featuring Supreme Knight Carl Anderson's annual report, begins at 1 p.m. and the States Dinner starts at 7 p.m.

The Mass on Wednesday, Aug. 8, to be celebrated by Cardinal Gérald Lacroix, Archbishop of Quebec and Primate of Canada, with homily by Cardinal Timothy Dolan, Archbishop of New York, begins at 8 a.m. EDT, as does the Memorial Mass on Thursday, Aug. 9, to be celebrated by Supreme Chaplain, Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore.


