



The Life Activities Committee note the following upcoming activities:

- 40 Days for Life The Msgr. Peter E. Blessing Council was represented at the Mass at the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul on September 25th to kick off the 40 Days for Life Campaign and the subsequent prayerful demonstration outside Planned Parenthood. Also, the tentative date for Blessing Council members to participate in the 40 Days for Life (praying at Planned Parenthood) is Saturday, October 19 at 10:00 AM.  - campaigns/providence/ or you can give your name to Life Director, John Murray, who can sign you up. Note, members can sign up for a time more conducive to their schedule or sign up for multiple vigils.
- <u>Silver Rose</u> The Silver Rose Prayer Service on Tuesday, October 2nd, at Our Lady of Good Counsel was cited by State Faith Program Director, Michael DeAngelis, as the best attended one to date. Father Paul Lemoi, Peter E. Blessing Council Chaplin, lead the ceremony. In drawing inspiration from the Memorare, he noted the role our Blessed Mother Mary has to combat the culture of death, "... never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided." Father also recounted the historic role the Columbian Squires had in developing the Silver Rose pilgrimage.
- Human Life Guild Day Saturday, October 5th, @ 9AM, Cathedral of SS Peter and Paul (don't have the full program yes; it begins with a mass then there are 5 presentations including Fr. Fleming; it was \$25 last year)
- <u>Life Chain Sunday</u> Sunday, October 6th (I'll ask Fr. Woolley if there are any plans at SS John & Paul, perhaps worthy GK Paul can ask the Round Table Chairmen for the other parishes whether they have plans)
- Mary Our Mother Celebration Brother Knights of ourthe Council will be participating in the celebration of Mary Our Mother at Saints John and Paul Church on Sunday October 13th. The scheduled events are mass at 9:30, praying the Living Rosary at 10:30, a pancake breakfast immediately after the Rosary. Tickets will be sold after all masses on October 5-6 (not at the door).


