



SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S CHALLENGE June 2022



"If you love me, you will keep my commandments." (Gospel for June 5, Jn 14:15)

Scripture makes it clear that actions speak louder than words. If we truly love Christ, we will act accordingly, living according to his commandments and the moral teachings of his Church. And we will do so remembering his commandment that we "love one another as I love you" (Jn 15:12). BROTHER KEITH A. PARENT 1958-2022



Sir Knight Keith A. Parent went to his final reward on the morning on May 10, 2022, after being in poor health the past few years.

Brother Keith joined the Knights in July 2008, obtained full Knighthood in March 2009 and became a Fourth Degree Sir Knight in December 2009. Past Grand Knight Tom Del Mastro recruited Brother Keith into the Order as his sons Nick and Matt were Columbian Squires at the time, and he was impressed with the fact that the Knights and Squires were welcoming of his son Matt who is confined to a wheelchair. Brother Keith also became a Counselor in the Father Leo Anctil Circle #5211 and served in that position until both his sons became Brother Knights in 2012. Brother Keith was also the last President of the Coventry Columbus Club serving in that position when the Council Hall was sold in 2011. Prior to the sale, the Council Hall roof collapsed during a heavy snowstorm, and Brother Keith was instrumental in obtaining the necessary repairs for a new roof.

Many Brother Knights and former Squires will remember Keith and his sons as always active in the Knights, attending many functions and taking part in activities up until Brother Keith's health started to deteriorate.
