Shortly our local schools will be welcoming back students for a new year of schooling, until then please continue to keep a watchful eye out for the young children playing in and around our streets of our towns.


Finally continue to pray the Rosary daily for the sanctity of all human life. Pray that any demonstration taken place because of our Supreme Court's decision will be non-violent.
