Chaplain's Message

Brother Knights,

Advent is a season of waiting and preparing. We will celebrate two feasts during this time. On December 8th, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and on December 12th, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, which we, as Knight of Columbus, recount in our yearly celebration of the Silver Rose ceremony in our parishes.

Back to Advent, we recount the celebration of the Lord's coming, His threefold coming. First, that He came in the past. In that coming, He took on our human nature. This was God's choice because of His great love for us, His children. Second, He comes to us in his Word, in the sacraments, in prayer and in the poor. We are to listen to His Word, we must be nourished by the sacraments, we are to make more time for prayer and we are to be mindful of helping the poor. Third, is that He comes to us in the future. It this coming we do not know the moment, the manner or the time. But we do know that it will come for each of us. St. Mark begins Advent with the simple but powerful words, "Be watchful! Be alert!"

Take time this Advent to prepare, pray the Rosary daily, receive the sacrament of Reconciliation, try to attend daily Mass and receive the Sacred Eucharist, and strive to help the poor of our communities. May you and your families have a blessed Advent Season and a joyous Christmas Season.

December 2023 Challenge

"'Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples ...'" (Gospel for Dec. 31, Lk 2:29-31)

Do you share the true joy of Christmas with others? Do you take time to invite others to deeper faith in the Christ Child? Do you speak of and celebrate the Advent and Christmas seasons in a way that reminds those around you of their true significance?




