


Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:


COMMUNITY Veterans Memorial Park Cleanup



We'll be cleaning up the Veterans Memorial Park on Saturday, November 8, starting at 9 PM. We want to make the park ready for Veterans Day on November 11.



FAITH Pilgrim Icon Sacred Heart Holy Hour



Our council will be hosting a Holy Hour in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, starting at 7 PM, at St. Vincent de Paul Church, 6 St. Vincent de Paul Street, Coventry. PLEASE JOIN US!

The holy hour, flowing from the jubilee for the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (Dec. 27, 2023 – Jun. 27, 2025) and inspired by Pope Francis' encyclical letter Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us) is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus.

During the holy hour, an icon depicting the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome, will be displayed.
